BABY SPLASH 'N' PLAY



Introducing a new offering for Bluesalt Swim School, our Baby Splash 'n' Play. These sessions are all about preparing your baby for structured swimming lessons as well as a beginning to explore water play.

Sessions will be running Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays 11:00am-11:30am, with a focus on <u>3-6month olds</u>. Once they reach 6 months of age, this will be a perfect transition into our 6-18month old toddler classes and will help provide a relaxing welcoming to our centre before structured lessons begin.

Benefits:

- Increases bond between caregivers and babies
- Early exposure to water
- Improve cognitive function
- Unstructured play



Sessions will commence from **28th of August**, with a cost of **\$7 per session**. One of our many experienced infant teachers will be on hand to provide any support or assistance if needed. We recommend bringing the following to your baby splash 'n' play sessions or your toddler classes in future:

- Your usual nappy bag supplies including nappies, wipes, change of clothes etc.
- Swim/ aqua nappy
- Bathers for you both
- A towel for you both
- A snack or feed for after your lesson



We have a ramp at the back of our pool building, accessible via our car park that allows you to bring the pram too! You are welcome to leave your pram on pool deck during classes to make changing and transporting your little one easier.

We welcome you to bring other family members or friends to watch you and your little one enjoy the water!

MAKE-UP POLICY

To be eligible for a make-up class you need to mark your child/ren away before class commences, this is to be done via the parent portal.

Unfortunately, if you do not let us know beforehand, we are unable to provide you with a make-up class. For further clarification please see our make-up policy on our website. If you have not yet accessed the **parent portal**, you can do so via our website.

Once you have marked your child away, you will be able to book your child in for a makeup class via the parent portal. The portal shows you all the current available options, please note that this does update constantly, and it only shows available classes up to 5 days in advance.

Office staff cannot book your child/ren in for make-up classes.
